For this summer, the GEO Gallery will be showing "Three's Company",









Solo Show at Geo Gallery- Call for Artists

"Come and Knock on our door... We've been waiting for you... Where the kisses are hers and hers and his Three's Company too!"

Hello Artists! I hope you all remember the Three's Company as fondly as I do. It was my first impression of California and I couldn't wait to move here and wear short shorts and ponytails.



Fast Forward to the present and it's time for you to try a Threesome - of paintings, that is!

A Triptych is generally one image spread across three panels. The panels can be any surface (canvas, paper, etc.) and orientation (horizontal or vertical) and are hung closely, or framed, together. I like it when each panel can stand on its own. This is just a challenge, not a requirement (see below for examples).

As the gallery is very small, we will be hanging them everywhere (Gallery style) and please-please-please, keep them small. (Under 11"w x 14"h)

I encourage you to try this technique as it is really fun. If you prefer, you can offer up 3 paintings that go together. A run, a trio, a family, a triangle. Even the same painting, done three different ways! We will be flexible. Art is due Saturday, June 26th. "Come and dance on our floor... We'll be waiting for you..."


AWARD AND SCHOLARSHIP NEWS ~ Jamie Butterworth

TIME TO VOTE

It's May again and time to vote for the officers and chairs who will support the activities of the BAA and all your efforts to explore and enjoy your art for the 2021-2022 year.

Normally, we would present the slate and ask for your acceptance at the May 19 meeting. Due to the Covid-19 restrictions, we have our meetings by Zoom. So, we will use our website again for the voting. It provides an on-line election feature. It only takes a couple of minutes to vote.

Please note that the list of Officer and Chairs are volunteers for the various positions who have accepted the nomination and agreed to work to continue the progress we make in the Burbank Art Scene. *You simply vote yes or no to accept or reject* the slate of officers and chairs proposed by the Nominating Committee.

Shortly, you will receive an email inviting you to vote. The email contains a link to the survey page. Also, at the bottom of our website main page will be the same voting link. You will be asked to log into the system. (If you don't remember your password or even knew you had one, just email <u>webmaster@burbankartassociation.org</u> for assistance). This way, we ensure that only BAA members will be involved. Also, you can vote only once. Voting is anonymous.

After logging in, you are directed to the survey. There is some introductory information, and then you make your choices. Then you will be given a page that summarizes your ballot.

If all is well, make sure to click on the "**SUBMIT SURVEY**" button at the bottom of the summery page.

The starting date for the voting is May 5, and the last day to vote will be May 19.

That's all there is to it. Thank you for your participation.
