In addition to the courses Katherine teaches,

she works as an Adjunct Professor of Art History at Moorpark College and an Art History Instructor for the full-time program at the Los Angeles Academy of Figurative Arts. She has recently begun teaching Art History at the new *Fifty and Better* program through Cal Lutheran University. She also teaches a weekly class on different artists and artistic styles at Sherman Oaks Village Senior Living Facility. She is a member of the Art Muse team, giving private museum tours and teaching classes.

Katherine has presented papers at The Representational Art Conference and at the College Arts Association on various topics in the past few years. She also serves as a Burbank Cultural Arts commissioner and volunteers at the Burbank Animal Shelter. In her free time, Katherine is an avid runner and enjoys traveling.

2021 BAA ANNUAL FALL SHOW

Annual Exhibits Chair Betsy Lueke Creative Art Center Gallery, November 5-18



Our annual Fall Show is coming soon to the beautiful Betsy Lueke Creative Art Center Gallery. The BLCAC is located at 1100 W. Clark Avenue in Burbank. If you are not familiar with the gallery, I recommend that you visit ahead of time to get a feel of the space. It will inspire and amaze you!

Take-in will be on Monday, November 1, 9:30 am - 12 noon. Opening night and Artists' Reception with awards will be held on Friday, November 5, 7-9 pm.

This show is for BAA current members with membership dues paid by the October 20 general meeting. (We will <u>not</u> accept membership payments at Take-in.)

As our membership has grown, I will have an "Intent-to-Enter" sign-up sheet at the September and October meetings to gauge the number of entries to expect. <u>The maximum size</u> for any entry is 36"x48".

Art Drop Off: Monday, November 1, 9:30 am to 12 noon. Please be prompt. No entries will be accepted after 12:00. The entry fee is \$20.00 (cash or check, payable at take-in). Judging takes place that afternoon.

Artists' Reception: Friday, November 5 at the BLCAC, from 7-9 pm. We will have a signup sheet for refreshments at the October meeting. (All participating artists are expected to bring something for the refreshment tables.)

Art Take-Down and Pick-Up: Thursday, November 18, from 9 am-12:00. (Arrangements can be made to pick up your artwork after 5pm on Wednesday, November 17 if needed.)

All submissions must meet BLCAC Rules & Regulations:

- **Frames** all work should be appropriately framed or with the canvas edges nicely painted. All wall art must be **properly** wired for hanging.
- Mats neutral colors.
- **Cover** watercolors, drawings, and other easily damaged work with glass or with Plexiglas if overall size is 18" x 24" or larger.
- Sculpture/Ceramic/Glasswork All pieces must be fired and auxiliary pieces securely attached. Work must not contain sharp points or edges and must be securely attached to pedestals with quake mounts. (The gallery supplies pedestals.)

We support and encourage our members to stretch themselves as artists, so if you have an exciting art piece that you would like to enter but are unsure if it meets these guidelines, please discuss it with me.
