2021 BAA ANNUAL FALL SHOW

Greetings BAA Members,

I am looking forward to seeing all of your fabulous entries to the upcoming Fall Show at the Betsy Lueke Creative Art center.

As a reminder -

Take-in is Monday, November 1, 9:30am-12noon
Opening night & Artists' Reception is Friday, November 5, 7-9pm.

The Fall Show is for current members. While we would prefer to have **membership dues** paid by the original October 20 deadline, we will accept membership renewals from current members at take-in, along with entry fees. However, I encourage both returning and potential new members to pay the annual dues <u>before</u> November 1st. This helps with planning for the exhibit as well as planning the year's budget.

Details about the Fall Show can be found in the September Newsletter on our website: www.burbankartassociation.org (go to Docs & Downloads, then Newsletters). But here's a quick recap:

- Maximum size for any entry is 36"x48".
- Entry fee is \$20.00 for one entry; \$15 for a second entry in a different category (cash or check).
- All wall art must be properly framed, finished and wired for hanging.
- Sculpture/ceramic/glasswork pieces must be fired and auxiliary pieces securely attached. No sharp points or edges.
- All participating artists are requested to bring something for the refreshment tables at the reception.
- Art Take-Down and Pick-Up is Thursday, November 18, from 9 am-12:00 pm.

A few words about commissions: Members shall pay 10% commission to the BAA on the sale price of any artwork sold at any BAA-sponsored exhibits, including the Fall and Spring Shows. For the Fall Show at the BLCAC, members will <u>also</u> pay a 25% commission to the gallery (Fine Arts Federation) on any artwork sold from the exhibit. So, please price your artwork accordingly.


Here are some art exhibits that are coming up you will want to attend!
